The Music Institute's goal is to inspire the next generation of music lovers. Founded 21 years ago by Board members Carol Nie and Harriet Parker-Bass, the Institute offers exceptional education to music students who demonstrate a high aptitude for learning and performing, within a nurturing and stimulating environment. In addition to private lessons, the comprehensive programs offer group classes, ensembles, and master classes with visiting Festival musicians and guest artists. Students build the technical skills needed to be proficient performers, while also learning music theory, history, and performance etiquette.

Beyond individual students, the Institute aims to serve the broader community. Research suggests that music education enhances both cognitive and social skills, leading to improved learning in all areas. The Institute proudly partners with Blaine County Schools to augment their efforts and improve overall student performance in the schools. These programs engage students from all backgrounds and support school initiatives with new, creative learning opportunities that help build selfdiscipline, focus, collaboration, and camaraderie.

True to the Music Festival's mission, the Institute's programs are accessible to all. While fees are assessed for private lessons, ensembles and group classes are free of charge. Financial aid is available for gualified students to ensure that anyone can participate regardless of financial status. Over 700 students participate annually in a growing number of summer and year-round programs.
